We recommend annual registration as our training methodology follows the cycle of the annual soccer season, if a player decides to take a season off, we recommend continuing to train with the team on a limited basis to stay in line with the development pattern of the team.

- Phase 3 Schools and youth activities can resume as normal: On-field training, play resumes.
 - Follow best practices and protocols to mitigate risk for safe return to play
 - Vigilant health and safety monitoring and response
 - o Take part in limited and local competition
