

ANNUAL DEVELOPMENT TEAM STRUCTURE for FALL 2020 – SPRING 2021

Community First Sports Club (CFS) development teams operate during the Fall, Winter, and Spring seasons. Accepted players can commit to the full annual soccer season (Fall, Winter, and Spring) or commit to any two seasons of play.

We recommend annual registration as our training methodology follows the cycle of the annual soccer season, if a player decides to take a season off, we recommend continuing to train with the team on a limited basis to stay in line with the development pattern of the team.

During the present and future realities of life in times of pandemic, CFS will operate in a phased approach that puts the health and safety of our players and coaches, their families, and the community first. We will strictly follow all federal, state, and local government mandates and guidelines, provide detailed health and safety information to our members, and implement best practices to mitigate the risk of spreading the virus through our club activities.

- **Phase 1 – Schools and youth activities remain closes:** Online Education at home.
 - Online training using video-conferencing
 - Offline training using *Core Skills Curriculum*, including a video library and training manuals
 - Weekly training, soccer culture, and video assignments with periodic player evaluations
- **Phase 2 – Schools and youth activities can reopen:** Online Education with limited on-field play.
 - Strict on-field social distancing policies
 - Vigilant health and safety monitoring and response
 - Continued use of Online Education and at home-training
- **Phase 3 – Schools and youth activities can resume as normal:** On-field training, play resumes.
 - Follow best practices and protocols to mitigate risk for safe return to play
 - Vigilant health and safety monitoring and response
 - Take part in limited and local competition
